Governor declares election date for two new Commissioners.

Marion, Kansas January 2, 2019

The special election to fill the vacancies created by the increase in the number of county commissioner districts in Marion County shall be held at the next regularly scheduled general election on November 5, 2019, according to a proclamation issued today by Governor Jeff Colyer.

The Marion County Republican and Democratic Parties now must each hold a convention between January 18, 2019 and January 28, 2019 to officially nominate their party's candidate for each position. Those official nominees will then have their names placed on the general election ballot. Any Republican or Democratic candidate living within the two new districts who wishes to be considered as a nominee should contact their perspective party chairperson for information:

Unaffiliated candidates living in one of the new districts may run for the position by filing a petition in the County Clerk's Office on or before January 28, 2019. The petition / filing paperwork will be available in the County Clerk's Office on or after January 3, 2019.

There will also be a write-in line on the November ballot. The two persons ultimately elected will take office as soon as the November election is certified, and will remain in office until the second week of January, 2021, when their successors take office for an initial two-year term.
