

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
MARION COUNTY, KS**

May 19, 2021

Commission met in special session at 9:00 a.m. in Commission chambers at the Marion County Courthouse with Chr. Randy Dallke, Comm. Dave Crofoot, Comm. Kent Becker, Comm. Jonah Gehring, and Comm. David Mueller present. Also present was Co. Clerk Tina Spencer. Present for portions of the meeting were County staff, members of the public, and members of the press.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the design for the proposed EMS Station in Hillsboro and authorize the purchase of the metal building. Material costs have been rising drastically, and since initial approval the metal building cost has increased over \$16,000.00. Another large increase is expected later this week. Potential cost-saving measures were discussed in order to try to keep the building project budget on track.

EMS Dir. Travis Parmley and Cody Nelson of NF Construction presented the proposed building design. After discussion, Mueller moved to approve the purchase of the building as shown on the plans. Crofoot seconded and motion carried 4-1 with Becker opposed.

Dallke noted that he would like frequent Board involvement in the building process and Board approval on building details as additional plans are developed. Dallke left the session and Vice-Chr. Crofoot presided.

Gehring moved to adjourn. Mueller seconded and motion carried 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
