

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
MARION COUNTY, KS**

November 17, 2022

Commission met in special session at 8:30 a.m. in Commission chambers at the Marion County Courthouse with Chr. David Mueller, Comm. Jonah Gehring, Comm. Kent Becker, Comm. Randy Dallke, and Comm. Dave Crofoot present. The purpose of the meeting was to canvass the November 8, 2022, General Election. Also present were Co. Clerk Tina Spencer, Election Clerk Michelle Looper, and Deputy Co. Clerk Ashley Herpich.

Crofoot nominated Catie Zurcher to serve on the Canvassing Board in his place. Becker nominated Nicole Reid to serve on the Canvassing Board in his place. Gehring nominated Hannah Branson to serve on the Canvassing Board in his place. Dallke moved to appoint the nominees to the Canvassing Board. Crofoot seconded and motion carried 5-0. Becker, Gehring, and Crofoot left the meeting.

Spencer reviewed the Election Summary Report. Preliminary results were provided for review. There were 53 provisional ballots. Pursuant to Kansas law, Spencer recommended that 27 be fully counted, one be partially counted, and 25 not be counted. Mueller moved to approve counting 27 provisional ballots, partially count one provisional ballot, and not count 25 provisional ballots. Dallke seconded and motion carried 5-0.

Approved provisional ballots were opened and scanned. Write-in votes and overvotes were reviewed and recorded by the Canvassing Board. Results by precinct were reviewed and provisional votes were added into the vote totals by precinct. Tie breakers were held for township offices.

Mueller moved to accept the results and certify the winners of the 2022 General Election. Zurcher seconded and motion carried 5-0.

Mueller thanked the Canvass volunteers and County election staff for their efforts in conducting a safe and secure election.

Dallke moved to adjourn. Zurcher seconded and motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 11:35 a.m.
