January 29, 2024

Commission met in special session at 12:30 p.m. in Commission chambers at the Marion County Courthouse with Chr. David Mueller, Comm. Jonah Gehring, Comm. Randy Dallke, and Comm. Dave Crofoot present. Comm. Kent Becker was absent. Also present was Co. Clerk Tina Spencer. Present for portions of the meeting were County staff, members of the public, and members of the press.

ADMINISTRATIVE: Gehring moved to approve the minutes of January 22nd. Crofoot seconded and motion carried 4-0.

- A draft letter of support for a Resilient Food Systems Infrastructure grant application being submitted by Happy D Ranch was reviewed by the Board. Gehring moved to proceed with the letter of support. Crofoot seconded and motion carried 4-0.
- Early check #55660 to the Kansas Department of Revenue for the Bait Shop sales tax remittance in the amount of \$238.29 was submitted for approval. Dallke moved to approve. Crofoot seconded and motion carried 4-0.
- Health Department Director Krista Schneider presented quotes for an additional vaccine refrigerator to be paid through grant funds:

- Open session resumed with a motion by Mueller to recess into executive session to discuss applicants for the EMS Director position pursuant to K.S.A. 75-4319b (1) for personnel matters of non-elected personnel with the Board, interview panelists, and Spencer present for 15 minutes until 3:32 p.m. Gehring seconded and motion carried 4-0.
