August 6, 2020

Commission met in special session in Commission chambers at the Marion County Courthouse at 9:00 a.m. with Chr. Jonah Gehring, Comm. Kent Becker, Comm. Randy Dallke, and Comm. Dave Crofoot present in person, and Comm. Dianne R. Novak present via teleconference. Also present were Co. Clerk Tina Spencer and Scot Loyd of Swindoll, Janzen, Hawk & Loyd. Present for portions of the meeting were County staff, members of the public and members of the press.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold a work session for the 2021 County budget.
