July 2, 2020

Commission met in special session in Commission chambers at the Marion County Courthouse at 4:00 p.m. with Chr. Jonah Gehring, Comm. Kent Becker, Comm. Dave Crofoot, and Comm. Dianne R. Novak present in person and Comm. Randy Dallke present via telephone. Also present were Co. Clerk Tina Spencer, Public Health Officer Diedre Serene, Medical Advisor Dr. Don Hodson, members of the public and members of the press.

The Board convened as the Board of Public Health to discuss Governor Kelly's Executive Order 20-52 requiring masks or other face coverings in public. Public Health Officer Diedre Serene and Medical Advisor Don Hodson both spoke in support of face coverings being worn in public settings.

After discussion, Gehring moved to produce, adopt, and authorize the Chairman to sign Resolution 2020-20, which recommends wearing masks but allows businesses and entities to control how they conduct business within their four walls, whether for or against (wearing masks) and recommends best practices including hand washing and social distancing. Novak seconded and motion carried 5-0.

Gehring moved to adjourn. Dallke seconded and motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 4:17 p.m.
