

Board of Directors Meeting

Dinah Richmond, Chairman asked for a motion to approve the January 21, 2022 minutes. Flo Rahn made a motion to approve the minutes, Pat Henderson second, motion carried.

The SCMC Board discussed filling the vacant position on Executive Committee. Pat Henderson volunteered to serve on Area 3 and Irene Bezdek volunteered to serve for Area 1. Barbara Craney made a motion to approve these two people on Executive Committee, Mary Rogers seconded and motion carried.

Gayla Ratzlaff, handed out Coordinator’s Correspondence and reported individuals, who received Economic Recovery monies would be receiving a letter from Federal government in regards to how much they received. This is to be used in filing Federal return for 2021. Discussed the May SCMC meeting since Gayla and possible Lanell Hett would be gone for this meeting. The board decided to go ahead and meet.
