Marion County Republicans announce convention to fill County Clerk vacancy.

The Marion County Republican Party will hold a convention on Thursday, January 18th at 7:00 p.m. at the Marion County Lake Hall, 1 Office Drive, Marion, to elect a qualified individual to be appointed by the Governor to fill the vacancy in the office of Marion County Clerk.

An application process has been developed for registered Republicans who are interested in being considered for appointment to the office. Packets are also available from Party Chair Rose Davidson and Party Secretary Cynthia Fleming.

Completed forms are due in the County Clerk's Office, 200 S. Third St., Marion, by Noon on January 18th.

In addition to submitting the Request for Consideration, <u>candidates MUST also receive a nomination and second from members of the Precinct Committee at the convention</u>. The current list of Precinct Committee Members will be distributed with the information packet and is also on file at the Marion County Clerk's Office.

The individual elected by the Party and subsequently appointed by the Governor will hold the office of Marion County Clerk for the remainder of the unexpired term (which runs through the second Monday in January 2025).
