This is to submit an application to rezone property. To accomplish this it appears I need to request the elimination of existing Rural Residential and have it changed to Agriculture and then request a change back to Rural Residential. This is to accommodate an increase in size and configuration of the plat.

Attached is a check for \$75 per our conversation for the 2 applications which will probably be handled as one resolution because this is basically a change in size and shape of a current plat.

It would be appreciated if you could provide me in the near future with a copy of the staff report originally prepared for the original zoning by my father, E. P. Klassen, and the minutes of the Planning Commission's hearing on that meeting. This rezoning action would have occurred in late 1996.
