

Development Plan:

APAC-Kansas Inc., Shears Division is requesting a Conditional Use Permit for a Temporary Asphalt Plant located in the Florence Rock Quarry for purpose of completing two KDOT projects on US Highway 50. These projects consist of 27 miles of Hot Mixed Asphalt pavement overlays on the mainline and shoulder on hwy 50 through Marion and Chase counties. These being KDOT projects APAC will follow all state mandated requirements for asphalt plants and plant sites. We will provide SWPPP and all appropriate permits required by the State of Kansas and any that the County of Marion may be requesting.

It is APAC's intent to use the Florence Quarry without a change to its current elevation. We would like to begin stockpiling materials for these projects as soon as possible. That operation consists of one man and a loader to push up incoming materials for several months and we will put in all necessary SWPPP controls for that operation. Construction will take place between April 1, 2011 and November 30, 2011. During this time there will be a Portable Asphalt Plant on location along with several other pieces of equipment, a lab and some office trailers. We will build any necessary berms and drainage that is needed for the asphalt plant and its operation and follow all KDHE rules and regulations. Additionally we have contacted the Department of Wildlife and Parks as well the State Historical Preservation Officer for their approval to use the location for our operations. It is our intent to use the current entrance as our ingress and egress to the plant. The asphalt plant should only be there for about 8 weeks, after that it is our intent to move it on to another project.

The location will be vacated and restored to its current condition upon completion of our contract with the KDOT.

We are currently applying for our own Construction Stormwater and Industrial Stormwater permits with KDHE. We have supplied you with the current plan and photos that Harshman Construction has for this quarry. I have modified Hartman's photos to show approximately where the asphalt plant will sit.
