Thanks for keeping me in the loop on all of this.

The SHPO and I consulted on the new location, and the Santa Fe Trail Assoc. through its local Chapter concurs with the SHPO findings. While we would really rather have the tower the 3/4 mile away per the FCC rules, the proposed Site Coordinates of 38-32-36.2 N, 97-13-19.1 W are acceptable because the tower owner has made a good faith effort to reduce impacts on the view-shed of the Santa Fe Trail by moving the tower, consistent with topographical constraints, while keeping the tower on the same parcel ownership.
