Beginning at a point on the East line of NE ¼ of said section 3, 786.00 feet South of the Northeast corner of said NE ¼; thence with assumed bearings, South 89 degrees 04 minutes 55 seconds West and parallel with the North line of said NE ¼, 264.00 feet; thence North parallel with East line of said NE ¼, 82.50 feet; thence North 89 degrees 04 minutes 55 seconds East, 264.00 feet to the East line of said NE ¼; thence South 00 degrees 43 minutes 55 seconds East along the East line of said NE ¼, 82.50 feet to the point of beginnings, containing .5 acres.
