

RESOLUTION NUMBER 04-03

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A ZONING CHANGE FROM "AG" AGRICULTURAL TO "RR" RURAL RESIDENTIAL ON PROPERTY LOCATED IN SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST OF 6TH P.M., OF STEPHEN KLENDLA.

WHEREAS, a public notice of above said zone change was properly given including publication in the official County newspaper at a public hearing.

WHEREAS, on the 22nd of January, 2004, the Marion County Planning Commission did hold a public hearing to consider the above zone change.

WHEREAS, the Marion County Planning Commission has recommended a zone change from "AG" Agricultural to "RR" Rural Residential.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Marion County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the said rezoning from "AG" Agricultural to "RR" Rural Residential on the following described property:

The North 330.00 feet of the East one-half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 10, Township 18 South, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M., containing 10.0 acres and subject to an easement for ingress and egress over and across the West 20 feet thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED it is hereby directed that the Marion County zoning district map be amended to reflect above said zoning change.
