## RESOLUTION NUMBER 04-19

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A ZONING CHANGE FROM "AG" AGRICULTURAL TO "RR" RURAL RESIDENTIAL ON PROPERTY LOCATED IN SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST OF  $6^{\text{TH}}$  P.M., OF DAVID VINDUSKA.

WHEREAS, a public notice of above said zone change was properly given including publication in the official County newspaper at a public hearing.

A tract of 10 acres located in the Northwest quarter of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 4 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Marion County, Kansas; being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the NE corner of said NW ¼; Thence S.89'29'59"W. (basis of bearing Geoid99) on the North line of said NW ¼ for 660.00 feet; Thence S.00'12'59"E. Parallel with the East line of said NW ¼ for 660.00 feet; Thence N. 89'29'59" E. parallel with the North line of said NW ¼ for 660.00 feet; Thence N.00'12'59" W. on the East line of said NW ¼ for 660.00 feet to the point of beginning. Subject to road right of way along the North side thereof and any other easements or restrictions of record.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED it is hereby directed that the Marion County zoning district map be amended to reflect above said zoning change.
