A RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING TEXT AMENDMENTS TO THE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR MARION COUNTY.

WHEREAS, a public notice of above said proposed text amendments to the Marion County Zoning Regulations was properly given by publication in the official County newspaper on April 3, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of May, 2013, the Marion County Planning Commission held a public hearing to address proposed new language concerning the definition of height.

WHEREAS, the Marion County Planning Commission, by a majority vote of the Commission, has recommended approval of amendments to the zoning regulations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Marion County Zoning Regulations shall be amended as follows:

Existing Language:

 BUILDING HEIGHT: The vertical distance from the established grade to the highest point on the roof or parapet wall.

Proposed new Language:

36. BUILDING HEIGHT: The vertical distance between the average finished grade along the front of a building and: (1) the highest point of the coping of a flat roof; (2) the deck line of a mansard roof; or (3) the average height level between the eaves and ridge line of a gable, hip or gambrel roof.
