## No Hunting

No person shall hunt or molest any birds or wildlife within the boundaries of the park.

No person shall carry or have in his possession any gun or fire arms in the park except law enforcement officers.

Hunting with or firing a shotgun, rifle, revolver, pistol, BB or pellet rifle, or BB or pellet pistol within the boundaries of the park shall be prohibited. There is a target range and it may be used by obtaining permission from lake superintendent.
