

**RESOLUTION NO. 8-07**

**A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURING WITHIN THE PLATTED AREAS SURROUNDING MARION COUNTY LAKE, MARION COUNTY, KANSAS**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF MARION COUNTY KANSAS:**


**SECTION 1:** The following outdoor burning activities shall be prohibited within the platted areas surrounding Marion County Lake in Marion County, Kansas, to-wit:


- (a) The careless use and disposal of smoking materials, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars and pipes. All smoldering remains shall be discarded in non-flammable containers and in a manner to reduce the potential for fires;
- (b) Building, maintaining, attending or using any open fire or campfire, except in permanent stoves or fireplaces or in barbecue grills in developed recreational sites or on residential homesites;
- (c) Burning of all fence rows, fields, vegetation, wildlands, ravines, trash, grass, lawns, leaves and debris or other areas or materials. Such burning may be exempted from these restrictions when it is necessary for crop survival and has been specifically approved in writing by the District Fire Chief. Crop survival means the burning of stubble in preparation for the planting of a crop.

**SECTION 2:** Violation of this resolution shall constitute a misdemeanor offense and shall be punishable by fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00.



