

RESOLUTION NUMBER 02-30

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A ZONING CHANGE FROM "AG" AGRICULTURAL TO "RR" RURAL RESIDENTIAL ON PROPERTY LOCATED IN SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST OF 6TH P.M., OF ELSIE FRIDAY.

WHEREAS, a public notice of above said zone change was properly given including publication in the official County newspaper at a public hearing.

WHEREAS, on the 21st of November, 2002, the Marion County Planning Commission did hold a public hearing to consider the above zone change.

WHEREAS, the Marion County Planning Commission has recommended a zone change from "AG" Agricultural to "RR" Rural Residential.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Marion County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the said rezoning from "AG" Agricultural to "RR" Rural Residential on the following described property:

Pt. of the SE/4 of Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M., described as follows:

Beginning at a point 560.63 feet South and 55 feet West of the Northeast corner of said SE ¼, said point is the West right of way line of the County Road; thence with assumed bearing, South 88 degrees 43 minutes 31 seconds West, 791.56 feet; thence North 02 degrees 16 minutes 23 seconds East, 560.40 feet to the North line of said SE ¼; thence North 88 degrees 43 minutes 31 seconds East along the North line of said SE ¼; 762.21 feet to the West right of way line of said County Road, said point is 60.83 feet West of the Northeast corner of said SE ¼; thence South 01 degrees 56 minutes 19 seconds East along the right of way of said County Road, 184.68 feet; thence South 00 degrees 07 minutes 58 seconds East along the right of way of the said County Road, 374.73 feet to the point of beginning, containing 10.0 acres.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED it is hereby directed that the Marion County zoning district map be amended to reflect above said zoning change.
