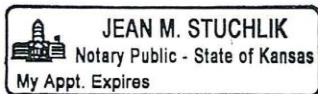

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-23**  
A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE FOR VETERINARY CLINIC IN THE "A" AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT ON PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1625 80th, PEABODY, OWNED AND OPERATED BY DR. VIRGINIA SKINNER.  
WHEREAS, a public notice of above said proposed conditional use was properly given including publication in the official County newspaper of a public hearing on October 5, 2011; and  
WHEREAS, on the 27th day of October, 2011, the Marion County Planning Commission held a public hearing to consider the above said proposed conditional use; and  
WHEREAS, the Marion County Planning Commission has recommended approval of a conditional use permit for a veterinary clinic at 1625 80th; and  
WHEREAS, the Marion County Planning Commission has determined that the conditions include:  
1) The CUP is only applicable to the final survey and said survey must be filed with the county as provided by law.  
2) A separate wastewater permit shall be obtained for the operation, with said permit to be approved by KDE and the system shall be sized and designed to accommodate the proposed uses.  
3) The site plan must be clarified regarding the placement of all signage and specific identification of the off street parking noted thereon, including designation of dog runs and any additional space need for future uses.  
4) All usage shall be consistent with the site plan approved with this CUP.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a conditional use is hereby approved for a veterinary clinic on property as presented for the following described property:  
E/2 NW/4 of SEC 34 TWP 21 RNG 3, Marion County, Kansas.  
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is hereby directed that the Marion County Zoning District Maps be amended to reflect above said conditional use.
