Dear Ms. Furrer,

Marion County Zoning Regulations state "no manufactured home shall be permitted ...that was constructed prior to April 1, 2001." Your 1965 CROS single wide trailer is in violation of these regulations as well as state law. Removal of the unit is the only way to correct the violation.

We understand that you will need some time to correct this violation. Therefore a deadline of November 30, 2010 has been established for removal of the unit. If you decide to move in a legal manufactured home, you will need to contact the Planning & Zoning office, and zoning setback requirements will still need to be met.
