- 7. Chairman reserves the right to conduct an orderly hearing and take whatever action is appropriate or necessary.
 - a) Please no applause, cheering, or other behavior not proper at a public hearing.

September 24th - 7:30 at this location. There will be no action taken by the Planning Commission on proposed zoning during this meeting.
