All participants must read the waiver of liability forms and the forms must be signed by the participants and their parent or guardian if a youth hunter. Until these forms are returned, no hunting parties may participate. Youth are anyone whom has not had their 16th birthday. All applications need to be in on time. All deer hunting dates and seasons are listed below. Number your choices in order of First choice, Second choice or Third choice as to your preferred hunting dates. Only permits for Unit 6 or Statewide any deer/ any season can be used. Muzzle loaders must have the proper permit if applicable.
